


Q1) Are you aware of the plans for Stanmore as part of the Local Plan Review 2018 Bridgnorth?















Q3) What capacity do you feel Bridgnorth has to absorb further major residential development?












Q5) Thinking about housing development in the Greenbelt, what level of development do you think is acceptable? 573 say none







Q6) What kind of housing do you think Bridgnorth and Worfield Parish most need?































Q12) Do you believe losing a large area of fertile, high grade agricultural land is acceptable in return for new homes? 937 SAY NO





















Q16) How trustworthy do you feel Shropshire Council is when it comes to consulting with and listening to local residents about these proposals? 81% Untrustworthy











Q18) What do you appreciate most about living in Bridgnorth, Worfield Parish or the surrounding area?













